














# SAFETY INFORMATION FOR THE TECH CAMPUS SEIBERSDORF PREMISES

Dear visitor,

Upon entering the Tech Campus Seibersdorf premises and acknowledging the following safety information, you agree to follow the safety regulations below for the duration of your visit and acknowledge that you act at your own risk.

All of the legally applicable health and safety regulations and accident prevention measures in Austria, especially the Health and Safety at Work Act (ASchG) and its ordinances, must be respected.

	Throughout the duration of your visit to the premises, your access card must be clearly visible both for safety reasons and to verify that you have permitted access to the Tech Campus Seibersdorf premises.
	Visitors are required to find their contact person immediately and leave the premises again via a direct route. Any other areas may only be entered when escorted by authorised personnel.
	Smoking and open flames are prohibited in all buildings.
	Taking photographs inside the buildings is not permitted for confidentiality reasons unless express permission has been granted in justified exceptional cases. Visitors may not disclose any information gained during the course of the visit to third parties.
	In the event of an emergency or technical incident, please call the emergency line: 050550 / 2333:
	Each floor contains first aid materials and a list of first-aiders at designated points.
	In the event of a fire, stay calm, call the fire brigade on 122 or activate the pushbutton alarm.
	Hand-held fire extinguishers are provided at the designated points.
	When the alarm sounds, please follow the green escape route signs along with your campus escort. Please follow the instructions given by emergency services personnel at all times. Rescue and escape routes must be kept clear at all times.
	When an alarm sounds, stay calm and head to the nearest assembly point.
	Entering areas of radiation is only permitted following prior consultation.
	Eating, drinking and smoking are prohibited in the laboratory areas.
	The road traffic regulations (StVO) apply on the entire premises! The maximum permitted speed limit is 30km/h.

Events: On entering the campus premises, you expressly agree to the unremunerated publication and use of any photographs, sound and video recordings taken as part of the event which may relate to you personally.
